1. Education & Childcare

3. Transport & Connectivity

Grantshouse is positioned on the A1, making it well-connected for both bus and rail travel.

- **Borders Buses (Route 60):** This is the primary local service, connecting Galashiels and Berwick-upon-Tweed via Grantshouse and Reston.
- **Regional Services (Route X62):** The X62 provides express connections between Edinburgh, Peebles, and Galashiels, serving as a vital regional link for commuters.
- **Rail Travel:** The **Reston Railway Station** provides direct services on the East Coast Main Line to Edinburgh and Berwick-upon-Tweed.

4. Community & Social Groups

Getting involved is the best way to meet neighbors and support local projects.

- **Grantshouse Community Council:** Meets regularly at the Village Hall to discuss local planning, environment, and funding. It is a central voice for residents.
- **Grantshouse Village Hall:** The hub for local activities, including CPR training, social gatherings, and committee meetings.
- **Grantshouse Development Company Ltd:** A local organization focused on community improvement projects. They are often looking for new members to help shape the village's future.
- **Environmental & Legacy Projects:** Keep an eye out for news on the "New Hub" project and wind farm funding opportunities (e.g., Quixwood) for local community groups.
